Rose Hill Cemetery

These new regulations are designed to preserve the appearance of the cemetery that means so much to so many. They are also going to be in place to keep the grounds keepers and visitors safe.

1. Glass containers/glass vases/glass lighting/solar lighting with glass decor/glass or ceramic figurines/etc. are NOT permitted at any grave site at any time.
2. Stuffed animals are NOT permitted at any grave site at any time.
3. Live flowers placed at the time of interment will be left a minimum of seven (7) days.
4. It is a suggestion that potted plants from the funeral NOT be left at the cemetery. They will be discarded right after the grave closing and may institute an additional charge for doing so.
5. NO planting of any kind in the ground near or between headstones or gravesites is allowed.
6. A Maximum of three (3) items are allowed per gravesite.
Examples: artificial flowers, a banner pole, and a flag.

Live flowers, a veteran marker, and a plaque.

7. Objects, such as a plaque that has a stand, a veteran marker, tripod wreaths/flower arrangements, or decorative metal trinkets WILL NEED to be placed on a landscaping block located to the SIDE of the headstone. To avoid disruption of the mowing and trimming and making it easier to maintain a cleaner look of the cemetery.
8. At NO TIME is the maintenance person responsible for lost, stolen, damaged, or removed items.

9. Artificial flowers are allowed year round, they MUST be placed to the SIDE of the stone or grave marker, but will be removed every April (weather and time permitting) for spring cleanup.
10. Artificial flowers may be removed at any time the maintenance persons feel fit to do so. Faded, ripped, wind blown/misplaced, and damaged flowers are just a few examples
